Call for Expression of Interest for Turn-key realization and operation of Marine Aquaculture District in Port Said: (LOT 1) and Turn-key completion of the K21 Hatchery in Agami, Alexandria (LOT 2)

1. The CIHEAM Bari, in partnership with GAFRD (General Authority for Fish Resources Development – Egypt), is implementing the MADE Project through the establishment of the following structures in Egypt:
LOT 1
 - a Marine Multi-Trophic Aquaculture Farm, Port Said Governorate
 - a Marine Hatchery (fishes and shrimps), Port Said Governorate
 - a Veterinary and Water Quality Research Center, Port Said GovernorateLOT 2
 - Work conclusion of the K21 Hatchery, Agami, Alexandria Governorate
2. The MADE Project is providing assistance to the Egyptian public and private actors in the sector of marine aquaculture, transferring advanced knowhow and technology in the Country.
3. The overall objective of the project is to contribute to developing and consolidating the marine aquaculture sector in the coastal areas of Egypt, providing a global assistance to the Egyptian public and private actors, transferring advanced know-how and technology in the beneficiary Country.
4. The specific objectives of the call for Expressions of Interest are:
 - a) Establishing an Aquaculture Technical District in Port Said
 - b) Conclusion of the new K21 hatchery in Agami, Alexandria
5. The mission of the contractor/s shall consist of “Turn-key realization and operation of the Marine Aquaculture District in Port Said” (LOT 1) and the “Turn-key completion of the K21 Hatchery in Agami, Alexandria” (LOT 2)”
6. The MADE Project hereby invites Company/Group with experience in the marine aquaculture sector to show their interest in realizing of the structure described above. The interested Company/Group shall express their interest for the two Lots or only one of them.
7. In order to confirm their eligibility for MADE Project’s financing, contractor/s should submit in their expression of interest a duly signed Statement of Integrity (appended to this letter).
8. Interested contractor/s must provide information evidencing that they are qualified and experienced to perform this contract. For that purpose, documented evidence of recent and similar contracts shall be submitted.
9. If the contractor/s is a Joint Venture (JV), the Expression of Interest shall include a copy of the JV Agreement entered into by all members. Alternatively, a letter of intent to execute a JV Agreement in the event of a successful proposal shall be signed by all members and submitted with the Expression of Interest, together with a copy of the proposed Agreement.
10. Determination of the similarity of the experiences, as reported at point 8, will be based on:
 - a) Contracts size,
 - b) The nature of contracts “marine aquaculture feasibility studies”, "realization and operation of marine aquaculture farms", "projects supervision”, or “Technical assistance to large scale projects”,

- c) The technical area and expertise of the Marine Aquaculture, covering all aspects of the business including marine aquaculture systems, marine hatcheries, environment, construction facilities of different marine aquaculture system (semi- intensive/intensive in earthen ponds; intensive in cages/tanks, etc in both Mediterranean and Red sea eco-systems);
 - d) The Client will also take into account for the evaluation of the applications the skills and availability of in-house technical back-up experts provided to the on-site experts.
11. Among the submitted applications, the MADE Project will shortlist a maximum of 5 Company/Group/Lot, to whom the Request for Proposals to carry out the realization shall be sent.
 12. The short-listed Companies/Groups will be invited to participate to technical surveys both in K21/Alexandria and in Port Said area, and be informed about duties and BoQ of the works.
